Dr. Bill Ferrier will give a presentation on raptor field injuries, ailments and viral diseases and how-to identify each for possible treatment. In addition, he will provide a suggested list of raptors first aid kit items. We have invited the CA Fish and Wildlife to come talk with our group about mew inspection and how to navigate their web page.

This falconry occasion is recommended for all individuals interested in learning a bit more about falconry and raptor care and is recommended for all apprentices and would be apprentices.
